



# Getting Married in Barbados 2012

---

Couple must apply for a marriage license from the Ministry of Home Affairs. Application can be made any time after arrival to Barbados. Wedding may take place any time after license has been issued and is valid for 3 months. License is usually issued at time of application.

**License Fee of US \$100.00 and stamp duty of US \$12.50 is payable with application.  
Fee for Wedding Ceremony by local Minister is US \$175.00**

For Catholic Weddings a notice must given of approx. three months and arrangements are made with own Parish Priest, who will notify the Bishop of Barbados. More information available on request.

## Documents required by authorities (must be originals or certified copies)

- Passport & Birth Certificate
- If any parties are divorced, proof of Decree Absolute is required.
- In case of widow/widower, the marriage certificate & a death certificate is required.
- If change of name, other than by marriage, proof required
